- Age: #RisingYouth Community Service grants are available for Canadian citizen, permanent resident or a person who has been granted refugee status in Canada between the ages of 15 to 30.
- Self Identifiers:
 - LGBTQ2+: Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, 2-Spirited First Nations, Metis or Inuit
 - Indigenous peoples in Canada, also known as Indigenous Canadians or Aboriginal Canadians, are the indigenous peoples within the boundaries of present-day Canada. They comprise of the First Nations, Inuit and Métis.
 - Visible minority: A visible minority is defined by the Canadian government as "persons, other than aboriginal peoples, who are non-Caucasian in race or non-white in colour".
 - Person with a disability: Federal laws define a person with a disability as "Any person who has a physical or mental impairment that substantially limits one or more major life activities; has a record of such impairment; or is regarded as having such an impairment."
 - Refugee: A person who is forced to flee from persecution and who is located outside of their home country.
 - Newcomer: Refers to landed immigrants who came to Canada up to five years prior to a given census year.
